**7) NEW BUSINESS**

**7a)** Tutorial followed by a tour of the new recharge basins

Upper Verde River Watershed Protection Coalition engineer Rick Shroads presented a map of the areas recharge basins, which are a joint venture with Yavapai County, Chino Valley, Prescott Valley, and Yavapai Tribal.

He explained different projects introducing new ways to increase rainfall runoff and/or capture sites for rainfall runoff. The current statistics indicate 2% rainfall aquifer capture and 98% evaporation. One project by the Upper Verde River Watershed Protection Coalition is using five (5) plots of land approximately ½ acre each treated with different soil surfaces to measure and compare volume and flow of the plots.

The committee discussed the following topics:

- Micro harvesting vs. macro harvesting
- Chino Valley annual precipitation is approximately 12 inches
- Senate Bill 1522, would allowed partial water credit for a developer who installed water retention facilities
- Surface water, ground water, and effluent (treated sewage) water legal state definitions, harvested rainwater definition pending.
- Soil types and affective ways of collection rainwater
