The July 4th events start around 1: 30 p.m.

Assistant Fire Marshall Smith advised the application and permit are the same as last year and the fire department's Shift A will monitor the fire hazard situation. Either she or Fire Marshall Chase will do a pre-inspection of the setup and fireworks prior to the actual lighting of the fireworks, are scheduled for a 20-25 minute duration. The only deterrent would be high winds (20 MPH). Fireworks Productions of Arizona from Chandler is a reputable company.

Councilmember Lon Turner participated by phone confirmed the plans for the fireworks.
