

**MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING

6. NEW BUSINESS

6a. Presentation and discussion by Dr. Penny Wills regarding Yavapai College plans for the Old Home Manor facility.

Dr. Wills reported on the progression of higher education, community colleges, and off campus sites, and distance education. Yavapai College goals are education, social and cultural activities, and economic development. Yavapai College's policy of a 10-year review of the college standing and a five (5) year budget process to develop an overall plan for the college. Upon review, by outside sources reflected, that enrollment in Chino Valley is low. Dr. Wills reported on the different programs that Yavapai College provides and which campus best suits these programs. Dr. Wills reported on the Yavapai College Chino center current and future programs, and how they interact with the Town's projects slated for Old Home Manor.

The committee discussed topics for keeping the Chino Valley campus open, space rental for Town programs, and expansion of programs. Programs discussed were linemen, vet techs, fire science, drone program and general education program. Increased enrollment is the key to keeping the campus open.
