

**CHINO VALLEY ROADS AND STREETS COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES

Councilmember Darryl Croft called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

3a. Approve the minutes from the April 24, 2012 meeting.
Ron Romley moved Dean Echols seconded to approve minutes with corrections on paragraph one regarding the median. Passed.

4. PUBLIC WORKS/TOWN ENGINEER'S REPORT - Refer to old business.

6. CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Mr. Peter requested information regarding the County paving Road 2 South and homeowners being responsible for the maintenance.
Ron Grittmann advised County has a preliminary design for paving Road 2 South, which they would maintain, as it would meet their public road standards.

7. OLD BUSINESS

7a. UPDATE ON ADOT PROJECTS

Highway 89 Sidewalk and Landscaping

Ron Grittmann advised ADOT has advertised for the bid. He advised there was a problem with the artist contract and specs on what the horse statue looks like. Project is ready to go the sidewalk portion should take 3-4 months, and the statue portion about 6 months.

Ron Romley asked about weed control. Ron Grittmann advised there is not an IGA with the county for weed abatement on the south end of town. Discussion ensued over establishing an IGA after the sidewalk and statue are complete.

- Roundabouts at Road 4 North and Perkinsville Road

Ron Grittmann distributed information on the roundabouts. He advised Perkinsville Road and Road 4 North are ellipse shaped due to limited right of way. Construction is slated for 2015-2016, ADOT is doing an environmental assessment by on their yard at Perkinsville and a there is a design for a small retention basin on the northeast corner.

- Highway 89 widening between Chino Valley and Pioneer Parkway

Ron Grittmann advised partial plans will be submitted august 23rd.

There is concern over the number of left hand turns between Road 4 South and Road 5 South the original plan was for 3 left hand turns.

Update on Town Projects

- Box Culvert at Road 2 North

Ron Grittmann advised construction on CBDG box culvert Center Street between cottonwood and railroad slated to start next week.

Road 2 North box culvert. Ron Grittmann advised there was a pre-bid meeting last week with 5 bids. While working with Chino Meadows Water System the crew found 2 hot APS lines on top of chino meadows water system lines they are awaiting APS relocation.

- Maintenance of Roadways and cost estimates for discussion

Ron Grittmann reported on roads budget and miles paved roadway surface in the Town. The committee discussed purchase of asphalt laying equipment, road standards, crew work, and cost of material. The committee directed Ron Grittmann to have information vetted and presented to Roads and Streets Committee.
